



## **Nerve Conduction Test**

Patients who have had nerve conduction studies describe the test as painless. Some patients describe a slight pulsing sensation or a mild electrostatic shock. A few patients find the procedure to be somewhat uncomfortable. The test is harmless, and each nerve can be evaluated in less than two minutes.

If you are scheduled for a Nerve Conduction Test, please follow these guidelines the day of your test:

- Wash hands thoroughly
- Do not use lotions or oils.
- Remove bracelets.
- Remove rings on middle and pinky fingers.
  
- Wash feet thoroughly.
- Do not use lotions or oils.
- Remove jewelry from ankles and toes
- Do not wear pantyhose.
